Details of the Statement

My child's name according to her Japanese birth certificate, also referred to as the Japanese family register (*koseki tohon*), is Hana Tanaka.

Her name according to her Australian Citizenship Certificate is Hana Citizen.

The reason for the difference is that we wanted Hana to use my wife's surname in Japan, but chose to register my surname for her for Australian citizenship, and this was acceptable to Australian Immigration at that time.
